BENTHAL CURRICULUM NEWS

This week the children in Y4 Hazel class were learning about electricity during their science lesson. They made a 'human electrical circuit' to role play how electricity travels from the battery to power the light bulb. Year 3 went to the Barbican to see the London symphony Orchestra. Year 6 have also been learning about electricity. Year 2 followed instructions to make a fruit yoghurt pizza and next week they will write up their own instructions using imperative verbs and time conjunctions. Pine Reception class enjoyed the book "Oh No George" by Chris Haughton, talking about times when its difficult to be good and how it feels when you get told off like George does in the book for making a mess. Year 1 have been learning how to subtract on a number line. Nursery learnt about polar bears this week, they read the book—Polar Bear, Polar Bear What do you hear? - by our focus author Eric Carle. They learned that polar bears live in the cold Arctic and are very good swimmers. The children also made polar pictures using handprints.

BENTHAL WINTER PLAYSCHEME

We are running a winter playscheme for children in all year groups from Nursery to Year 6, who are entitled to Free School Meals from Tuesday 2nd January until Friday 5th January, from 10:00am - 2:00pm.

This provision is free of charge and a nutritious lunch will be provided. Activities will include arts and crafts, a range of sports, indoor and outdoor games. The Playscheme will be run by Benthal's experienced playworkers and nursery nurses, who will ensure the children have lots of Christmas fun activities.

There will be a trip to Little Angel theatre on one of the days to see a Christmas puppet show (free of charge).

All children currently eligible will have received an email already. If you think you are eligible, or need help with your Free School Meals application, please contact the School Office.

Registration for places need to be received by **Friday** 15th December at 9am.

We also offer paid places to children not entitled to Free School Meals, the cost is £12 per day.
