I can report that the advisor was very impressed with what they saw, particularly with the children's strong knowledge of the topics they were learning; a high level of subject specific vocabulary being used by the children and pupil engagement in lessons. The final comment to the Senior leadership team was that Benthal is much further ahead in the curriculum content compared to other schools. This was very pleasing to hear as you can imagine. A huge thank you to all the staff for their continued commitment to ensuring that Benthal is an academic and creative school.

Finally, Berthal Parent Voice will be having their second meeting with myself and the Parent Governor for Stakeholder Voice soon. They will be asking you for some feedback to a few questions during next week. Each rep will then present the opinions of their class parent body which will be discussed at the meeting. I am so pleased that we now have this up and running giving all of our parent/ carer community in the school a voice.
