CHRISTMAS PLAYSCHEME

We are running a Christmas Playscheme at Benthal for children entitled to Free School Meals on **Friday 27th**, **Monday 30th**, **Tuesday 31st December and Thursday 2nd January**. Playscheme will be open **10:00am - 2:00pm** each day.

This provision is **free of charge for children entitled to means -tested Free Schools Meals**. If you think you are eligible or need help applying, please contact the School Office. If you are not eligible, the cost is £12.00 per day.

This playscheme is funded by the DfE Holiday Activities and Food Programme, with the aim to encourage pupils to eat healthier, be more active, socialise and take part in more physical and creative activities.

A nutritious lunch, cooked on site, will be provided each day.

Children can take part in arts and crafts, board games, Lego, indoor and outdoor sports. We also have exciting outings planned to the cinema, Kidzmania soft play and Lee Valley skating rink.

The playscheme will be run by Benthal's experienced playworkers, nursery nurses and learning support assistants (for children requiring 1-2-1 support).

If your child is due to start Reception in September 2025, you will need to apply online **before Wednesday 15 January 2025**.

Applications must be made via **www.eadmissions.org.uk** - you will need to create an account with an active email address before completing a new application.

Free school meals

So no child goes hungry

From September 2023, all state primary school children in London will be eligible for free school meals for the next school year, saving families hundreds of pounds.*

At the time of calculation (May 2022), the average cost to families for a primary school meal was around £2.30 in London. This represents a cost saving per child of around £440 over 190 school days across the academic year. Source LACA Ltd.
