

## Mathematics

In maths, we will continue to focus on counting, recognising numbers and forming numbers. The children will also have opportunities to spot patterns and identify shapes. For topic, the children will be recording how much their plants have grown and sorting animals into animals that live on land or in the sea.

We will be singing lots of songs to develop counting skills.



## Physical Development

The children will take part in a PE session every **Friday** with Coach H or myself.

The children will continue to develop their gross motor by playing in our playground.

The children will also practice their fine motor skills, through fun activities where they will use tools like tweezers, spinners, scissors and pencils.

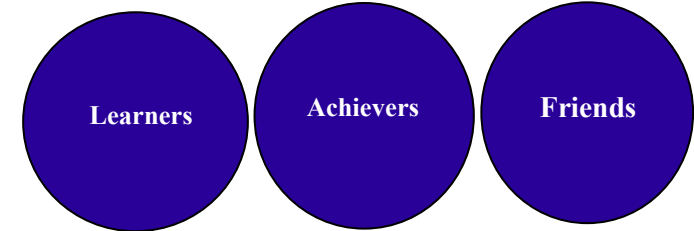

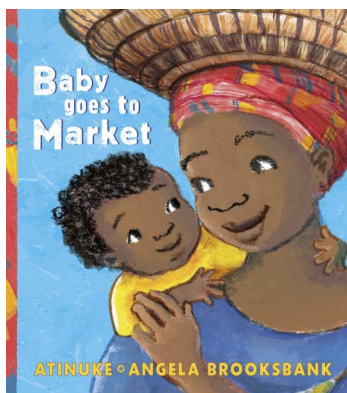
## Nursery Mulberry Class

## Communication and Language and Literacy

### Understanding the World

This term our class topics are **In the Garden** and **Under the Sea**.

For **In the Garden**, we are learning about where our food comes from, trying new foods and having a go at planting our very own seeds. We will then observe what the seed needs to grow.

For our topic **Under the Sea**, we are very lucky as we will be visited by a marine biologist who will run a session on the ocean and how we can protect it. We will also have a go at making our own floating boats and test what materials work best.
