Peripatetic music lessons continued on line from January 2020 and were resumed as face to face sessions from mid-March. All PPG pupils received weekly sessions and sheet music and activities for practice were provided by tutors.</p> <p>The number of places taken up by Pupil Premium pupils for peripatetic music lessons were 1 for Flute & Clarinet 5 for Ukulele, 4 for Brass lessons and 8 for violin. All pupils attended weekly lessons as well as online tuition during school closure.</p> <p>Day visits were organised for all pupils in years 4, 5 & 6 to attend Kench Hill & Frylands outdoor centre. This was to promote well-being and outdoor learning as well as to support social development as part of secondary transition. 1:1 support was also provided for PPG pupils with EHCPs. Panto performances took place in the school.</p>
