Peripatetic music lessons continued on line from January 2020 and were resumed as face to face sessions from mid-March. All PPG pupils received weekly sessions and sheet music and activities for practice were provided by tutors. The number of places taken up by Pupil Premium pupils for peripatetic music lessons were 1 for Flute & Clarinet 5 for Ukulele, 4 for Brass lessons and 8 for violin. All pupils attended weekly lessons as well as online tuition during school closure. Day visits were organised for all pupils in years 4, 5 & 6 to attend Kench Hill & Frylands outdoor centre. This was to promote well-being and outdoor learning as well as to support social development as part of secondary transition. 1:1 support was also provided for PPG pupils with EHCPs. Panto performances took place in the school.
