FREE SCHOOL MEALS Eligibility Update Protection from roll out of Universal Credit extended from 31/03/23 to 31/03/2025

The Free School Meal (FSM) protections policy was introduced in 2018 to protect those eligible for FSM from becoming ineligible while Universal Credit (UC) is being rolled out. The end date for protections has now been extended from March 2023 until March 2025.

This means that a pupil who was FSM eligible on 1 April 2018, or who has become eligible under benefits/low-earnings criteria since then, will continue to receive free meals, even if their household income exceeds the eligibility threshold, up until March 2025 and then until the end of their phase of education.
