We continue offering free taster sessions in our breakfast club (8am-9am) and playcentre (3.30-6pm). A range of fun-filled and educational activities are on offer every day, as well as indoor and outdoor games, crafts and sport. We serve nutritious breakfast with a choice of porridge, cereal, bagel or toast in the morning and tasty hot meals after school in the playcentre. The price of our breakfast club provision is £2.50 and free of charge for children entitled to free school meals. The playcentre costs £13.50 per day and £8.50 for children entitled to free school meals. We accept childcare vouchers and tax free childcare payments, allowing you to save more on childcare costs.
