## Playcentre

We are pleased to let you know that we have increased our playcentre and breakfast club capacity so can accommodate our working parents' needs. Our playcentre and breakfast club now take children from 3 year old and you can also use Tax Free Childcare account for pay for these services. If you get Tax-Free Childcare, the government will pay £2 for every £8 you pay your childcare provider via the online account and you can get up to £500 every 3 months (£2,000 a year). Please apply online at https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-tax-free-childcare or feel free to speak to office staff for more information.

## Free School Meals

If your child is eligible for "free school meals" and you register them for this, we will receive extra funding called "pupil premium". We use this extra money to improve the educational provision and resources at the school.


Your child might be eligible if you access a number of benefits, e.g. income support, income-based jobseeker allowance or employment and support allowance, Universal credit, Child Tax Credit (with annual gross income of £16, 190) or Working Tax credit run-on.
