We had another successful Summer Playscheme at Benthal, provided free of charge for children entitled to means-tested Free Schools Meals.

This year we extended the scheme to children outside of Benthal.



The playscheme is funded by the DfE Holiday Activities and Food Programme, to encourage children to eat healthier, be more active, to socialise and take part in more physical and creative activities. A freshlycooked nutritious lunch was also provided each day.

Collection and Drop off Arrangements

Please be reminded that all parents are welcome to come into the school playground at drop-off and pick up times and wait with their child from Years 2-6 in the football pitch (the new astroturf area). Please note that the playground gate on Rendlesham Road opens at 8.40am, however, there is no school adult supervision until staff come on duty at 8.50am. Children on site in the playground during those 10 minutes remain the responsibility of their parents/carers. Juniper families must go to the classroom door with their child, at drop off time (8.55am) and pick up promptly at 3.25pm.

If you are not collecting your child after school, please let the office know in advance the name of the adult who will be collecting them.

Extended Childcare at Benthal

We continue offering all Benthal nursery and reception children free playcentre and breakfast club provision, please collect the registration form from the office if you are interested.

For Reception class pupils who have now moved up to Year 1, free extended childcare offer has now ended.

If you would like your child to continue attending extended services, Breakfast Club is $\pounds 2.50$ per day and the Play Centre is $\pounds 13$ per day.

For pupils, eligible for means-tested Free School Meals, Breakfast Club is free of charge and Playcentre is $\pounds 8.50$ per day.

All payments must be made online via ScoPay account before using any school services.

If you would like to register for our extended childcare provisions, application forms are available from the School Office. We accept childcare vouchers and Tax-Free Childcare payments.
